

LOS ANGELES HARBOR HOLIDAY AFLOAT PARADE

Assemble in East Basin at **5:45 P.M.**

Parade starts at **6:00 P.M.** Sharp

Radio Frequency for Participants: Channel 68

Alternate Radio Frequency: Channel 69

In case of a torrential downpour or dense fog: Standby and Monitor Channel 68 for **Operations Announcements** between **5:00-5:15 P.M.** and at 5:45 P.M.

Emergency – Port Police (310) 732-3500 or VHF Channel 16

Be sure your boat has an appropriate number of operable fire extinguishers and PFDs aboard. Please follow the instructions of the Port Police and the U.S. Coast Guard / Coast Guard Auxiliary. Note: Tall ships and large vessels that cannot make turns in narrower channels may periodically drop out of the parade route.

To help alleviate congestion where the parade turns in front of Holiday Harbor Marina, the 3rd judging station will again be on east side of the channel at Cabrillo Way Marina. Boats will be judged on the way into the fairway, rather than after the turn on the way out. Parade boats with a mooring at or beyond Holiday Harbor can return to their slip when they reach the turning point.

A Port Police or Coast Guard Auxiliary vessel will be stationed at the turn to direct all other parade boats through the turn.

The Parade Dinner and Awards Presentation will be at Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club December 6th, Doors Open at 5:00 Dinner starts at 6:30 Dinner Tickets can be purchased for \$15 at a skippers' meeting or at the door Children 10 and younger \$8.00.
