Please proceed past the vessel displaying Flashing Blue Lights or Flashing Red & Yellow Lights before making your turn.

Judging for the parade will take place at the Battleship Iowa and the Cabrillo Way Marinas. The Parade speed will be 5 Knots please attempt to reduce gaps in the parade when they form and maintain speed to smooth the flow of traffic.
